



My Journey: Nine-Slide Power Point

The final assignment is a comprehensive PowerPoint which tells about your life as a student. How did you get to this point and where are you headed from here? These presentations often become some of the favorites of the whole year. We are such a diverse and talented group, that this gives you an opportunity to showcase all that we are. Please put time and effort into creating this

presentation as it stands as an example of the kind of student (and person) you are and the one you want to become. You will present your presentation in a Zoom style meeting. You will screenshare your presentation for us to see as you discuss. You do not have to speak for long, not more than 2-3 minutes. Your presentation could be a video that you have pre-narrated, or whatever you want it to be as long as it includes the information below. **BE CREATIVE!**

Format:

Use font sizes, colors, and pictures that your audience can actually read

Edit your slides for error

Don't just read the slides to us. We can read. Speak from your heart.

Power Point Slide Requirements: Add pictures to most or all of your slides. You may also include video, sound, transitions, etc. Make it something you will be proud to show.

Slide #1: (Title Page) Create a title page that lists your name, a favorite quote, and has pictures.

Slide #2: Revisit your educational journey: Tell us what schools you went to, what you were involved in. Show us where you came from.

Slide #3: Even though we have been together for four years, we don't all know each other. Creatively show your audience who YOU are. This may include your friends, family, hobbies, likes/dislikes, special talents, special circumstances or struggles you overcame, etc.

Slide #4: Reflect on your experience/s at CMHS and how it has helped you grow as an individual, student, and human being. What will you remember when you leave CMHS (personally, academically, socially)? Please don't waste our time with negativity. It would be the very definition of hubris to act like you've learned nothing or grown none. Don't be THAT guy.

Slide #5: Think about your time at CMHS. What is one (or two) assignment, project, experience that you really learned from? Tell the audience about the experience. What did you learn? Could just be something you enjoyed doing or experiencing.

Slide #6: Create a collage or slide that illustrates your academic, extra-curricular, and/or other type of involvement/ activities here at CMHS. Verbally explain why you chose to be a part of these activities and how these activities shaped you. You may say additional comments; this is just a starting point.

Slide #7: Life after CMHS. Tell your audience about your goals for the future. Why have you chosen these goals and how will you achieve these goals? In all, what type of impact do you want to have on your community, family, friends, and even the world?

Slide #8: Tell us one thing that you don't think we know about you. It can be just a fun fact or a personal revelation. Just give us something that you think would surprise us.

Slide #9: Final words. How do you want to end this presentation? Students may sing songs, read poems, play their guitar, show a video, create a collage of personal pictures, or simply make a thank you slide for the people, including CMHS staff, parents, and friends, that influenced them throughout their four years at CMHS. *You decide; but remember, end powerfully and make it memorable. *Lastly, you should thank your audience.*
